Dr. Sharma is one of India's leading cardiologists and a highly respected medical academic. His expertise lies in interventional cardiology and coronary, valvular and congenital interventions. Currently Dr Sharma is Professor and Head of the Cardiology Department at Bombay Hospital & Institute of Medical Sciences, Mumbai.

Much sought after for his insights and expertise, he is often invited to deliver guest lectures at prestigious meetings around the world. Some such events have been the meetings of the World Congress of Cardiology, Asian Pacific Society Meetings, Mount Sinai Hospital New York Symposium, American Society of Hypertension, Cardiac Society of Australia and New Zealand and SAARC Cardiac Society. Dr. Sharma's engagements as an academic include examinership for super speciality degree D.M. (Cardiology) in various Universities. He is also on the selection panels of several universities and teaching institutions.
