She has also been the Organizing Secretary for two prestigious International Conferences, on behalf of the CII (Confederation of Indian Industry). She is on the Editorial Board member of Clinical Pulmonary Medicine.

As a Rotarian, Dr.. Chowgule has regularly conducted a chest disease clinic in the tribal adivasi village of Talwada since 2000, as part of her many roles towards corporate social responsibility.

Armed with an MD degree from Grant Medical College, Mumbai University and Fellowship in Pulmonary Critical Care from Loyola University Medical College and the Hines Veteran Hospital (II, USA), Dr.. Chowgule has published over 38 peer-reviewed papers in prestigious journals on her two areas of expertise and interest – Pulmonology and Environment.
